EXTENDED CALL FOR ABSTRACTS

The submission deadline for Abstracts for the 20th International Conference of Diseases of Fish and Shellfish has been **extended to 14th May 2021**. Submission Contributions that fit into one of the following topics (see list below) may be submitted for oral or poster presentation. All submitted contributions will be peer-reviewed by an expert panel. Different oral sessions will be arranged based on the scientific quality of the contributions, and the number of papers submitted on each topic. Those abstracts not selected for oral presentation will automatically revert to poster presentation and will be placed in a suitable poster session. The decision of the organisers on this matter will be final. In the case of your submissions not being selected for oral presentation, please indicate whether you are willing to present it as a poster.
